

## “Bring On Your Stash” Bracelet



### Supplies:

Beading wire, crimps, wire guard and magnetic clasp

Approximately 2 ½ inches of small chain

Size 6 o seed beads

Size 11 o seed beads

Assorted beads, various sizes

Fireline or beading thread of choice

1. Begin by attaching your clasp. You will put a crimp, the wire guard on the beading wire, run through the loop of your magnetic clasp. Add one end of your chain. Run the beading wire through the other side of the wire guard and back through the loop. Crimp.
2. Place as many size 6 o beads on the beading wire as you need to achieve desired length.
3. Add a crimp, the wire guard and go through the other end of the magnetic clasp. Now add the other end of the chain and take the beading wire back through the wire guard and crimp. Crimp. As you get ready to crimp this end, be sure to leave ¼ to ½ inch of slack, that will be taken up as you add the embellishments. This should secure the bracelet.



- Using a good length of fireline, secure the thread at the beginning of one end of the bracelet. Position your thread to be coming out of the size 6 o bead. Pick up 11 size 11 seed beads and go back through the size 6 o seed bead. This will create a loop. Repeat for all of the size 6 o seed beads.



- Once Step 5 is complete, mix your assorted beads together. Position your thread at the beginning size 6 o seed bead. Add 2 beads and then a size 11 seed bead. Take your thread around the seed bead and go back through the other two beads. I generally start with the larger bead, going to the smaller beads. Now go back through the size 6 o seed bead. This will position itself on one side of the size 6 o bead. Pick up three more and repeat on the other side of the size 6 o bead. Repeat for all off the size 6 o beads.
