


O-oh! Bracelet

Let's have fun mixing shapes & colors

Material

- O - 12 gr "O" Beads 3.8x1mm
- SD - 12 gr Super Duo
- SB - 4 gr Seed Beads 11/0, round
- P - 3 Crystal Pearls 6mm
- 6 lb. FireLine®



- 1** Start with thread in a length that you feel comfortable. String 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O, repeat this sequence three times. Go back and pass through first sequence and through the next SD. Pass through the second hole to get ready to make the second diamond. (pictures 2 and 3).



- 2** String 1O, 1SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1 SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O. Close the diamond passing through the first SD. (picture 4) Walk the thread until the second SD and pass through the second hole to get ready to make the third diamond. (picture 5)





- 3** Repeating step 2, make all diamonds needed to reach the desired length, minus 1" for the clasp.
Then string 1O, 6SB, 1 Pearl, 1 SB. Go back passing through the pearl and 3SB.
Pick 3SB, 1O and pass through SD in opposite direction. (picture 6)
You may walk the thread again to reenforce) .

Start the second row:

Pass back through the first hole (of SD) and reach the next SD on the side. (pic. 6)



- 4** String 1O, 1SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O, close the diamond passing through the first SD in this sequence (pictures 7 and 8).



- 5** Pass through the beads until you get the third SD. Pass through the second hole and get ready to make another diamond. String 1O, 1SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O, pass back through the first SD available of the first row.
(Please see pictures 8 and 9)



- 6** (Picture 10). To close the diamond string 1O, 1SB, 1O and passing through the next SD on right, walk through the beads until you reach the second SD and pass through the second hole to be ready for another diamond.



- 7** Repeat steps 5 and 6 until you complete the second row. String 1O, 21SB, go back and pass through the 18th SB making a ring. String 3SB, 1O pass through the next SD in the opposite way. You can walk the thread all the way around to reenforce the "ring". (Pictures 11 e 12)




Important: Try it! make sure the ring fits the pearl and they work well as a clasp, pick less beads if necessary.

- 8** Pass through the second hole. Walk the thread until you reach the first SD of the first row. Pass through the second hole and make another ring. (picture 13) Now you start the third row. (picture 14)



- 9** Make the first diamond of the third row. String 1O, 1SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O, close the diamond passing through the first SD. (pic. 15)
Walk the thread to reach the next SD and pass through the second hole. (picture 16)



- 10** Make the third ring following the instruction on step 7 and get ready to make the third row. (picture 17)



- 11** String 1O, 1SB, 1O. Pass through the first SD available on the second row. (picture 18)



- 12** String 1O, 1SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O, 1SD, 1O, 1SB, 1O and pass through the first SD of this diamond. (picture 19)
Walk the thread to make another diamond. (picture 20)

13 Repeat steps 11 and 12 until you have all diamonds of the third row done.



14 Let's make the clasps.
String 1O, 6SB, 1 Pearl, 1 SB. Go back passing through the pearl and 3SB.
Pick 3SB, 1O and pass back through the SD. (you may walk the thread again to reenforce) .
Walk the thread to the second row, repeat this step to make the last clasp.

15 End all threads. Congratulation!
